Snow Removal

Now that the winter months are here, Village residents need to be aware of plowing crews out doing snow removal operations. The Village, through its annual budget, plows the sidewalks of the Village. These walks are plowed by 7:30 AM and again by 2:30 PM Monday through Friday. They are plowed on the weekend as needed. The Village board does not wish to shift the burden of sidewalk snow removal onto the property owner.

Please refrain from plowing snow from private property onto or across public roads. This presents a hazard to drivers and is, in fact, illegal (Highway Law 214 NYS V&T law 1219). Snow should be kept on private property in an area that does not obstruct your view or that of drivers on the roadway. It is also best to plow snow to the right side of your driveway (if looking toward the road) to avoid having snow that has been cleared from blocking your driveway again after the plows pass by. If you hire someone to plow for you, please remind your contractor of these rules as well. We appreciate your understanding in this matter.

The dates for the 2025 Ontario County Free Rabies Clinics have been announced. All vaccinations are free, but donations are appreciated. Animals must be at least 3 months of age and healthy. They must be on a leash or in a carrier, one pet per carrier. No more than 4 pets per person. Preregister https://www.ontariocountyny.gov/rabiesclinic. If you have a past rabies certificate for your animal, please bring it with you. The dates for the clinics are as follows: 2/15, 4/12, 5/24, 7/12, 9/20, and 11/1. All clinicas are at the Ontario County Public Works at 2962 County Road 48 in Canandaigua from 9am-Noon.Contact the OCPH at 585-396-4343 with questions.
