From The Mayor

The Village has purchased four solar speed signs and installed them at the entrances to the Village. Hopefully, this will alert drivers to reduce their speed on Village streets.

The November election is approaching. While we encourage you to place signs of support in your yard, please be mindful of the following. Signs must be placed on the house side of the sidewalk out of the right of way and must be removed as soon as possible after the election.

Brush Pickup

The scheduled **brush pickup is the week of October 10th**. Please have your brush by the curb with branches parallel to the road but not in the road or in the gutters. You may bring your brush to the WWTP Monday through Thursday from 8 am until 3:30 pm. **We are not able to take leaves.** Please do not rake leaves into the gutters or into the street and please keep the gutters and the street free of grass clippings, as they clog the drainage system.

Annual Water Quality Report

The Village is required by the Dept. of Health to have the water tested regularly throughout the year. We are also required to submit an annual report summarizing the water testing results. The annual report for 2021 is complete and you can find it on the Village website. Copies are also available at the Village office. You will be pleased to know that our water is not in violation of any contaminant levels, including lead; and meets all DOH Standards.

Blood Donation

It is not often that donating an hour of our time can save a life. But that is what happens when we give blood. Because blood is so vital, our bodies nearly always make more than enough to meet our own needs. Donating some of our "spare" blood can literally save lives! We have people in the Village office who have had family members saved by blood donations. There are many collection sites in Ontario County. Bloodmobiles travel to many work sites, schools, churches, and community organizations. The 2022 Special Collection Event dates have been released! Most events require pre-registration with the exception of paper shredding and pumpkin recycling. Rabies Clinics

Because we have documented rabies in our county, New York State Law requires every dog, cat, and ferret at least 3 months of age be vaccinated against rabies at all times. Each year Ontario County Public Health provides six free rabies clinics throughout the county. The 2022 rabies clinics run from 9AM-Noon and the final clinic for 2022 is scheduled for **October 15th**. The clinic will be held at the Ontario County Public Works at 2962 County Road 48 in Canandaigua. The clinic is FREE but donations are appreciated. Dogs, Cats, and ferrets must be healthy and at least 12 weeks old. Bring your most recent rabies certificate with you if possible. Pets must be on a leash or in a carrier.
